To: BEP Recipients (All Divisions)From: Asset Preservation DepartmentDate: February 6, 2020Re: Asbestos Licensing Requirements

At the directive of the Special Inspector General for the Troubled Asset Relief Program ("SIGTARP"), all **Recipients are required to provide an active state-issued asbestos license for the contractor(s) associated with the inspection of all BEP structures demolished after February 1, 2020.** 

If a structure is demolished after February 1, 2020, Recipients are required to provide the following information with the demolition claim:

- 1. Invoice for demolition of structure with date of service on/after February 1, 2020;
- 2. Asbestos inspector's active, state-issued asbestos license; and,
- 3. Invoice for testing/remediation listing the address of site(s) serviced and the date of testing/remediation.

If there is no invoice for asbestos testing available (as the service was provided by the demolition contractor or a sub-contractor as part of the cost established in the bid packet) then Recipients are required to provide the following information with the demolition claim:

- 1. Invoice for demolition of structure with date of service on/after February 1, 2020;
- 2. Asbestos inspector's active, state-issued asbestos license; and,
- 3. Asbestos testing <u>report</u> listing the address inspected and results.
